

#### **Definition of Communication**


Communication is simply the act of transferring information from one place to another, whether this is:

- vocal (using voice)
- written (using print or digital media such as reports, websites, or emails)
- visual (using logos, maps, charts, or graphs)
- non-verbal (using body language, gestures, and the tone and pitch of voice)




#### **Effective Communication Enables Us to:**


